Question:

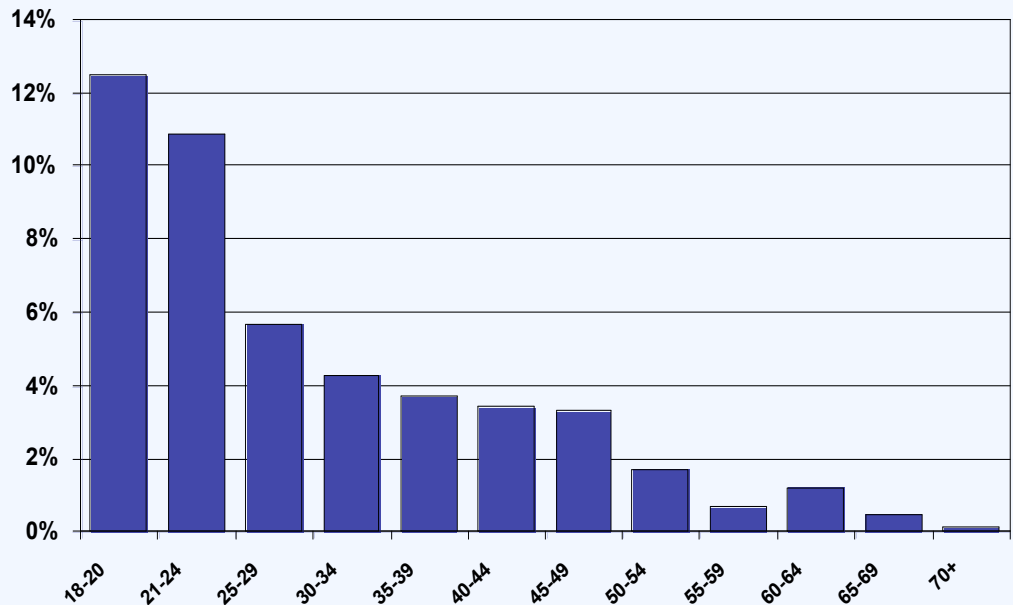
Are youth under the age of 21 becoming addicted to or dependent on alcohol?

Answer:

Yes, at alarming rates. As you can see, 18-20 year olds have higher rates of prevalence than any other group, followed by our 21-24 year olds. These youth will in all likelihood require intervention and treatment services.
